The Department of Natural Resources and Environmental Control (DNREC), Division of Fish and Wildlife Will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, March 25, 2025, beginning at 6 p.m. to consider comments from the public on the proposed revisions to DE Admin. Code 3801 Shellfish Aquaculture (Docket #2024-R-F-0018).

This proposed revision of 7 DE Admin. Code 3801 - Shellfish Aquaculture should improve operations for the shellfish aquaculture should improve operations for the shellfish aquaculture industry in Delaware's Inland Bavs while ensuring shellfish aquaculture remains compatible with commercial and recreational finitishing and shellfish, boating navigorian and public safety, public water access and use, and native biota. The Shellfish Aquaculture regulation will be amended by incorporating the three specific recommendations of the Shellfish Aquaculture Task Force (Task Force). The Task Force, created during the 2024 General Assembly session by Senate Concurrent Resolution 103, was charged with examining all aspects of shellfish aquaculture in the Inland Bays and making recommendations to increase shellfish aquaculture participation and praduction.
